The **£9.2m programme** is looking to fund partnerships between industrial companies willing to trial and demonstrate energy efficiency technologies on-site and developers of such technologies. The Carbon Trust has been chosen to manage this fund on behalf of BEIS and we have one question for you:

The competition will be open until summer 2018. Applications will be reviewed periodically with the following **application deadlines: 20th December 2017, 28th February 2018, 30th April 2018, 30th June 2018, 31st August 2018** (or until funding is exhausted).

Successful applicants should expect to receive between **40-60% of total** project cost, with IEEA contributions typically between **£150,000 and £750,000 per project**. There is scope for a small number of exceptional projects to receive more than £750,000. In addition, successful applicants can expect to receive project support during the demonstration period.
