Categories

There are 3 categories:

Entry criteria

For each category, please submit up to 500 words explaining why you should win the award. The activities you mention must have taken place between 1st June 2018 and 31st May 2019.

You can also provide supporting documentation to help give the judges more context. To keep entries manageable, we're limiting the supporting documentation to 5 items. Each image, page of a pdf, or spreadsheet counts as an item. So if a pdf is 5 pages long, it counts as 5 items. If a spreadsheet workbook has 5 tabs, it counts as 5 items.

Emerging Engineer of the Year

- The engineer's background and when he or she joined your company
- Learning and development achievements
- Technical achievements
- Ways the engineer has contributed to the company/industry

This award recognises initiatives that have had a tangible impact on health, safety and the environment. They can be initiatives run internally or in conjunction with external partners. Your entry should cover information such as:

- The challenge you were looking to overcome and what the initiative's goal was
- Who was involved, internally and externally (as relevant)
- How it was implemented and how you measured success
- The impact it had

Company of the Year

This award recognises general excellence within the metalforming industry. Your entry should cover successes across multiple areas, for example:

- Innovation – e.g., technical, HSE, operations
- Training and skills development
- Commercial achievements – e.g., new market penetration, market share growth, new products/services, marketing
- Industry engagement – e.g., partnerships, leadership roles, charity work

Your entry should cover information such as:

- The challenges you were looking to overcome and what your company's goals were
- Who was involved, internally and externally (as relevant)
- What actions you took and how you measured success
- The results and impact you've experienced
